### Reminder of the new secondary school start time

In response to the government white paper in March 2022, we have had to slightly adjust our timings of the day in line with new requirements. We will now expect students to be in school at **8.20am** for an **8.30am** start in lessons. The school buses have not been changed as they should all be arriving on time to support this (subject to the usual roadworks!). Students will not be penalised should school buses be late due to roadworks.

## **BEST system**

We have introduced our new B.E.S.T. System (Behaviour; Expectations; Sanctions; Targets - rewards).

This is replacing the BfL (behaviour for learning) procedures. Please can you familiarise yourself with these as there are significant changes aimed at supporting many of our students, including next day detentions. We have a bigger emphasis on rewards to encourage students to show our school values of 'Care; Commitment; and Courage'. The new behaviour procedures can be downloaded here.



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#### **School buses**

## **School meal news**

It is with regret that we must inform parents that, after three years, we are having to increase the price of our school meals due to the cost-of-living increases. We are increasing the price of a meal deal from £2.25 to £2.40 from Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022. We have worked on an increase of 6% on all food available through the catering team.
