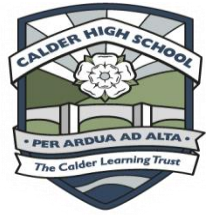
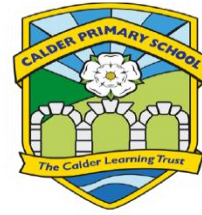

Year 10 GCSE Geography trip to Ilkley – Monday 10th July

As part of their Geography GCSE course students need to carry out an investigation based on their rivers topic. The research carried out in Ilkley will provide students with a deeper understanding of the theory behind rivers and allow them to write up their investigation on their Paper 3 exam which will make up 37.5% of their final grade. Departure and arrival times are listed below; however, these are dependent on traffic.

Students need to bring:- Pens, pencils, rubber, etc., small bag, waterproof jacket/coat and a packed lunch.

Students will be with their Geography teacher at all times and due to the nature of the site, it is essential that they listen carefully to all instructions. Students do not have to wear school uniform.

Please note that this trip is an important part of the preparation for the GCSE unit 'Physical landscapes in the UK' and as a result, the school is able to subsidise the cost for students receiving Pupil Premium by 20% (reducing the cost to £12).

Please be reminded that Calder High School is a cashless school and no cash will be accepted on site.
