Death penalty
Criminal has to do set number of hours' work in the community as their punishment
Sense of right and wrong
Physically hurting the criminal as punishment
Breaking the law
Where the punishment puts someone off committing the crime
Something we are bound to do
Something/ someone considered morally wrong
Letting go of anger towards someone for a wrong they have done
A crime committed because of prejudice

Locking someone up as punishment
Making things fair again
The rules which govern a country
The enforcement of rules
Release of a criminal from prison, but continuing to monitor their behaviour
Monitoring of behaviour with the threat of greater punishment for offending again
To keep people safe
Helping the person to see how or why they should behave better
Making up for, compensating
Getting back at the person for what they have done

Victim	The one against whom a crime is committed
Vindication	The punishment exists because the law does
Young offenders	Persons under 18 who commit crime
