Finalised Plans for Summer School: Monday 23rd August – Friday 27th August 2021

We are delighted that your child is going to be part of this year's Summer School. With almost 80% of the year group taking part, we are so excited about meeting our new year 7s!

The Summer School programme is designed for students to make new friends, develop their skills in literacy and numeracy, and ultimately have as much fun as possible. This is an important opportunity for the students as the normal transition programme couldn't take place this year due to Covid restrictions.

Please be aware that our current plans outlined below, may need to be amended following any changes in government advice.

Timings

Summer School will run from 8.35am – 3pm. Students should go directly to the top entrance on Brier Hey Lane where a member of staff will be waiting for them. Students will return to the diner at the end of each day, where they will be dismissed and trusted to make their own way home or remain with staff until they are collected.

Lunch

Students should bring their own packed lunch and drink with them each day. Please note that students are requested to bring enough water/drinks for the day. If your child receives a free school meal, this will be provided.

Clothing

Students should wear clothing that they can move easily in and are able to get dirty. We would suggest that students wear layers, so they can add/remove throughout the day as they see fit. If the weather is good, students should bring their own sun lotion, hat and sunglasses. Please be aware that students will be responsible for applying their own sun lotion.

Mobile Phones

Students are allowed to bring mobile phones, but they should not use them during the sessions. Please be aware that students bring these items at their own risk and we cannot be held responsible for them.

This may be useful for notifying staff if your child will not be able to attend or to let us know about any last minute changes to collection. Students are expected to attend for the full week. Please email school if exceptional circumstances prevent this from being the case.

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, students will experience the typical school day with interactive, fun-based lessons in English, Maths, Science, PE, Music, MFL and Technology.
