

PE Consent: Extra-Curricular Sporting Activities

The PE Department participates in practices, fixtures and activities throughout the academic year in a wide range of sports accessible to students of all abilities and age groups. Most, but not all, of these take place after 3pm and will be completed by 5pm.

The PE department communicates such events to both students and parents in a variety of ways including reminder slips, posters in school, parental letters and the use of Facebook (Calder High PE) and Twitter (@CHS_PE). Please be aware that all PE activities can be subject to change as a result of weather conditions and competition requirements. It is the responsibility of individual students to ensure they are fully aware of the details of all practices and fixtures and to inform staff, as soon as possible, if they are unable to take part in an activity.

Transport to and from away fixtures would normally be provided by the school, in the form of minibuses, coaches or taxis. A member of staff will usually accompany students, however it is guaranteed that all drivers will have a full DBS certificate.

The PE department will not be able to include any student in their activity programme until the generic parental consent slip below is signed. Please keep this in the planner as a record for the rest of the year.

In the event of an emergency, all PE staff will be in possession of a full set of student medical records and parental contact information.

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Parental Consent includes the following:

I agree to my son/daughter to take part in extra-curricular sporting activities at Calder High School.

I give permission for my son/daughter to walk to and from an after school home activity/fixture unsupervised and at their own risk.

I give permission for my son/daughter to be 'dropped off' en route from an away fixture, if deemed appropriate by a member of staff, and then to make their own way home at their own risk.

I agree to authorise any member of staff during the course of an activity/trip to authorise any medical treatment for my son/daughter, as deemed necessary, in the event of an accident or emergency.

I undertake to inform the school of any change in medical circumstances.
